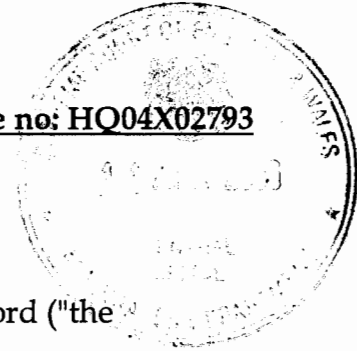

**PENAL NOTICE**

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

**If you do not obey this Order you will be guilty of contempt of Court and you may be fined or sent to prison or may be guilty of a criminal offence for which you may be fined or sent to prison or both.**

**THE ORDER**

**IT IS ORDERED that:-**

1. In this Order "Respondents" means:
  - (i) any of the Defendants
  - (ii) any person who has been give notice of the terms of the Order made on 10 November 2004 by being served with a copy of that Order or otherwise;

- (iii) any person congregating with or acting in concert with any of the persons referred to above in pursuit of the campaign to prevent or obstruct the building of the Research Laboratory in South Parks Road Oxford; and
  - (iv) any person served with a copy of this Order.
- 2. The Respondents shall be restrained by injunction during the period set out in paragraph 3 below from congregating or picketing within 100 yards of:
  - (i) The University Examination Schools in the High Street; and
  - (ii) The University examination hall at Ewert House Summertown or entering those buildings.
- 3. 18 April 2006 to 20 July 2006 (excluding Saturday 22 April 2006) and 10 September 2006 to 31 October 2006.
- 4. There be liberty to apply.
